Two significant events will be taking place this weekend as MENDAKI works together with the community in efforts to enhance Muslim pre-schoolers' readiness for school. As part of its School Ready Campaign, professionals, practitioners as well as parents and their children will be engaged in a series of capability building initiatives.

Education Symposium on Saturday, 14 April 2018 at NUS Shaw Foundation Alumni House

The MENDAKI Education Symposium, inaugurated last year will feature 14 speakers, providing insights into how technology is impacting the teaching and learning of preschoolers. Themed "Raising Young Innovators in a Digital World", the symposium will feature 4 main speakers followed by two breakout sessions. Keynote speaker, Dr Elizabeth Chesworth from the University of Sheffield will give focus on creating spaces for learning to thrive with other speakers focussing on different aspects of technology in the early childhood learning. Targeted at professionals and practitioners, the 1-day symposium will also showcase teaching aid and learning tools that can enhance the classroom experience.

PlayFest on Sunday, 15 April 2018 at D'Marquee Downtown East

Working in tandem with preschool teachers, parents play a crucial role as their child's first teachers especially at home. Recognising the importance of play in a young child's development, MENDAKI will hold its inaugural PlayFest as part of its public education initiative to engage and disseminate information to parents and families with young children. See how a home is transformed to provide opportunities for teachable

moments for the family. Among the various activities, parents and their children will get first-hand experience at creating and making various objects for play and learning.
