Speakers & Panellists Profile

A/P Jason Tan

Associate Professor Tan is a well-regarded scholar in the research areas of education and national development, and comparative education. He is currently associate professor in policy and leadership studies at the National Institute of Education (NIE).

Associate Professor Tan has more than 20 years of experience in the field and he has published extensively. His publications include Education in Singapore: Taking Stock, Looking Forward (2012) and Challenges Facing the Singapore Education System Today (2001). He is also an international editorial board member of several international journals, including Asia Pacific Journal of Education, and Globalisation, Societies and Education.

Muhd Shamir Abdul Rahim

Mr Muhd Shamir Abdul Rahim is currently the Managing Director of Sypher Labs Pte Ltd. Prior to this; he was working in the pharmaceutical and healthcare industry including a 3-year stint with Sanofi-Aventis.

As a business development manager for an incubator, he helped launch several biomedical start-ups. Muhd Shamir graduated from the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a University Scholar with a Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Biomedical Science with a minor in Technopreneurship, attained during his internship at First Round Capital as part of the NUS Overseas College Programme at the University of Pennsylvania.

He pursued his Honours research on stem cell therapy in regenerative bone treatment at the Institute of Molecular Cell Biology (IMCB), an A*STAR research institution.

Capt. Mohd Salleh Ahmad Sarwan

Capt Mohd Salleh Bin Ahmad Sarwan is the Director of Singapore Maritime Academy. Capt Mohd Salleh received his Master Mariner (Class One Deck Officer) qualifications in 1989 and a Master's Degree from Loeb-Sullivan School of Business, Maine Maritime Academy in 1999 with a scholarship from Singapore Polytechnic.

Capt Salleh was a Navigating (Deck) Officer (from Deck Cadet to Master Mariner) with Neptune Orient Lines before joining the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) as the Economic Affairs Officer and Expert on Maritime Transport before taking on his current portfolio.

For all his hard work both in the industry and with SMA, Captain Salleh has been presented a multitude of awards, including the Distinguished Teacher of the Year Award for Excellence in Teaching (2000). He also won the Best Media Award in the Excellence in Teaching Convention, not once, but four times in 2000, 2001, 2004 and 2008, for actively developing & promoting the use of IT in Teaching and Learning.
