Challenging Grammar Questions

"who" or "whom"
(Question) The man is speaking is my father. (Question) The man you met previously is my father.
Use "who" if the word after the blank is a VERB.
Use "whom" if the word after the blank is a NOUN/PRONOUN.
(Question) "She's never eaten durians before,?" asked Kate curiously.
Look at the present perfect tense of the main sentence. In this case, it is "She's never" which is the same as "she has never" or "she has not".
The question tag for such question is always the opposite of the present perfect tense. Therefore
She has not → has she?
He is → isn't he?
He was → wasn't he?
