Anugerah MENDAKI

The Anugerah MENDAKI will be awarded to students who have received exceptional results in national examinations including PSLE, GCE-N,O,A Levels, NITEC/Higher NITEC/Technical Engineer Diploma, International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB), NUS High Diploma, and Diploma with Distinction/Merit from all Polytechnics, LASELLE College of the Arts, National Institute of Education and Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts.

Anugerah Cemerlang MENDAKI

The Anugerah Cemerlang MENDAKI is awarded to graduates of LASELLE College of the Arts, Nanyang Technological University, National University of Singapore, Singapore Institute of Technology, Singapore Management University, Singapore University of Social Sciences, Singapore University of Technology and Design and other prestigious universities who have obtained first class honours degrees or equivalent.

Anugerah Gemilang MENDAKI

Also known as MENDAKI Pinnacle Award, this award was introduced in 2019 to recognise exemplary individuals who embody the 3Cs – Character, Competency and Citizenry – values that contribute to the Community of Success.

Academic Achievement AWARD

This is awarded to students who topped the cohort in their respective course of study. Since 2019, in addition to the usual representation from the ITE, Polytechnic and University categories, we have also extended this award to the top Muslim student at IB and GCE-A Level.

Special Achievement Award FOR EXCELLENCE (SAAE) (Non-Academic)

This award is given to students between ages of 14 and 25 who have done exceedingly well and attained an award at the National, Regional, or International platforms in a non-academic field.

She left the airline industry in January 2022 and resumed her study at ITE Collage East in April 2022 where she pursues her newfound interest in Nursing and her childhood dream to be a Nurse.

In 2021, Sri joined Singapore Nurse Association (Student's Nurse Chapter) for her Co-Curricular Activities (CCA). Displaying her dedication and commitments to the club and possessing great leadership and communication skills, she was eventually elected as the President of the club in 2022. Sri actively promoted the club to the new intake students where she and her team managed to recruit close to 200 members.

In June 2021, July 2022 and October 2022, Sri earned a place in the Director's List for 3 consecutive terms for her outstanding academic performance, in the top 10% at ITE College East.

As an exco member for Red Cross Youth Chapter CCA, Sri was involved in the Blood Donation Drive in the College. In November 2022, she was given the opportunity to participate in the International Youth Exchange Programme; 100th Anniversary Japan Junior Red Cross as well as appointed First Aider for WorldSkills ASEAN held at Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre.

Sri was also the representative for the Singapore Young Leader Program. She was given the opportunity to attend various dialogue sessions such as the SG Perspective 2023 with Mr Baey Yam Keng, Senior Parliamentary Secretary, National Youth Council (NYC) ITE Forum Group Mentoring Session with Mr David Tay, Deputy Director, Youth Engagement & Youth Leadership NYC, and Empowering Youth Through Dialogue with Mr Teo Chee Hean, Senior Minister and Coordinating Minister for National Security.
