ABOUT THE AWARDS

There are six types of Anugerah Awards

Anugerah Gemilang MENDAKI

Also known as MENDAKI Pinnacle Award, this award was introduced in 2019 to recognise exemplary individuals who embody the 3Cs – Character, Competency and Citizenry – values that contribute to the Community of Success.

Anugerah Cemerlang MENDAKI

The Anugerah Cemerlang MENDAKI is awarded to graduates of LASELLE College of the Arts, Nanyang Technological University, National University of Singapore, Singapore Institute of Technology, Singapore Management University, Singapore University of Social Sciences, Singapore University of Technology and Design and other prestigious universities who have obtained first class honours degrees or equivalent.

Academic Achievement Award

This is awarded to students who topped the cohort in their respective course of study. Since 2019, in addition to the usual representation from the ITE, Polytechnic and University categories, we have also extended this award to the top Muslim student at IB and GCE-A Level.

Anugerah Belia Cemerlang MENDAKI (Non-Academic)

Formerly known as the Goh Chok Tong Youth Promise Award, the Anugerah Belia Cemerlang MENDAKI aims to inspire the community towards skills mastery and support youth in their quest in attaining various peaks of excellence. The overseas and local awards both support Muslim youth with potential in diverse fields beyond academic areas, such as in the domains of culinary, sports, music, design, creative industries including performing and visual arts.

Special Achievement Award for Excellence (SAAE) (Non-Academic)

This award is given to students between ages of 14 and 25 who have done exceedingly well and attained an award at the National, Regional, or International platforms in a non-academic field.

Salifian Bin Sulaiman is a highly accomplished graduate of both the National University of Singapore (NUS) and Waseda University, Japan. He achieved Honours with Highest Distinction in History from NUS, and received straight A's in his studies at Waseda, where he majored in International Liberal Studies. He also completed the University Scholars Programme (USP) and was placed on the NUS USP Presidential Honour Roll, Senior Honour Roll, and Honour Roll. At Waseda, he was awarded the Dean's List twice in his four terms there. Salifian was also an NUS scholar, under the Wee Cho Yaw Future Leaders Award, which recognises young individuals who demonstrate vision, resilience, and a commitment to serving others.

For his academic and civic excellence, Salifian was named Valedictorian of the NUS College Class of 2025 and is a recipient of the Izzudin Taherally Prize, one of the College's highest honours, reflecting consistent academic excellence, leadership, and commitment to social harmony during his undergraduate years.

In recognition of his outstanding potential, Salifian was awarded the 2025 Rhodes Scholarship (Singapore Constituency), making him Singapore's 30th Rhodes Scholar. His academic interests are driven by a commitment to understanding and uplifting vulnerable and minority communities, inspired in part by his own lived experiences. Salifian is especially passionate about exploring how migration, faith, and education intersect to shape social mobility, especially among working-class families in Southeast Asia and beyond.



Salifian's academic interests are closely tied to his commitment to social uplift, education, and cultural inclusion. He is the founder of SALAM, a student society that supports the underrepresented Malay/Muslim community at NUS College and promotes interfaith dialogue. The group has grown to over 50 members and continues to organise community engagement events, including Iftar sessions and interfaith dialogues with religious leaders and students.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Salifian also founded Blossom As One (BAO), a social impact organisation. The group's activities include a charity drive that raised over \$2,000 for the Children's Charities Association of Singapore, and working with small businesses in Hokkaido to improve their online presence and social media outreach.

His commitment to community service also includes volunteering with the Foundation of Rotary Clubs, where he tutored underprivileged students in Clementi. He also has deep pride for his neighbourhood, taking up the role as the Lead Researcher for the Montreal Park Heritage Board under Sembawang Town Council, where he curated a historical display that now stands in the newly opened public park.

Salifian is currently pursuing a PhD in Anthropology at the University of Oxford with the Rhodes Scholarship. He will be researching migratory issues, specifically on ambitious individuals and the negotiations of their various aspirations. He aspires to share stories of migrants around the world, contribute to research in Singapore, and mould young minds in the local universities.
